



Road G Project (Westside Employment Center)


- 2,100 Acres of Undeveloped Land
 - 1,388 Acres Public (66%)
 - 1,257 Acres Port Owned (60%)
 - 698 Acres Private (34%)
- Formation of an LID to Facilitate Infrastructure Development
 - 53% of Private Ownership Approve
 - Formation of LID Approved by Port Commission March 11th 2019
- Project Includes
 - Entrance to Highway 17
 - 3 ½ Miles of Road Bed
 - Water, Sewer and IWW
 - Resolve Power Needs



Planning for the Future

Northern Columbia Basin Rail (NCBR) Project

- **Construction of 8 Miles New Track**
- **Rehabilitation of 3 Miles Existing Track**
- **20 mil in State Funding**
- **10 mil in Federal Funding**
 - **Federal Obligation Fall 2019**
- **Construction to Begin Spring 2021 and Conclude In 2022**
