




Percent change in jobs from before the recession






Median hourly wage





Change in median hourly wage Excludes federal jobs








Percent change in jobs from before the recession






Median hourly wage, 2016 Excludes federal jobs






Change in median hourly wage Excludes federal jobs






Median household income Adjusted for inflation






Percent of personal income earned outside of the county, 2015








Kitsap housing permits through July






Taxable sales, retail outlets Adjusted for inflation and seasonality








Population growth: net migration








Median hourly wage, 2016 Excludes federal jobs






Change in median hourly wage Excludes federal jobs






Median household income Adjusted for inflation






Percent of personal income earned outside of the county, 2015








Thurston housing permits through July






Taxable sales, retail outlets Adjusted for inflation








Population growth: net migration





Age of workforce, 2016








Percent change in jobs from before the recession






Median hourly wage, 2016 Excludes federal jobs






Change in median hourly wage Excludes federal jobs






Median household income Adjusted for inflation






Percent of personal income earned outside of the county, 2015








Whatcom housing permits through July






Skagit housing permits through July










Population growth: net migration








Median hourly wage, 2016 Excludes federal jobs






Change in median hourly wage Excludes federal jobs






Median household income Adjusted for inflation






Percent of personal income earned outside of the county, 2015








King housing permits through July






Pierce housing permits through July






Snohomish housing permits through July








Median hourly wage, 2016 Excludes federal jobs






Change in median hourly wage Excludes federal jobs






Median household income Adjusted for inflation






Percent of personal income earned outside of the county, 2015








Clark housing permits through July






Cowlitz housing permits through July








Percent change in jobs from before the recession






Median hourly wage, 2016 Excludes federal jobs






Change in median hourly wage Excludes federal jobs






Percent of personal income earned outside of the county, 2015






Taxable sales, retail outlets Adjusted for inflation








Population growth: net migration
