Purpose: Rules are necessary for the Employment Security Department (department) to implement provisions of the Long-Term Services and Supports Trust Program under Title 50B RCW. WAC 192-01-001 dictates what chapters of Title 192 WAC are assigned to programs administered by the department and include Unemployment Insurance under Title 50 RCW, Paid Family and Medical Leave under Title 50A RCW, and portions of the Long-Term Services and Supports Trust Program under Title 50B RCW. Amendments to WAC 192-01-001 are necessary to assign chapters 192-900 through 192-999 WAC to the Long-Term Services and Supports Trust Program.
